




AUDITORIUM:-

NURSING FOUNDATION LAB:

This is perhaps the most primary and essential laboratory. Here students are given practical insight through training which incorporates various biological and behaviourial sciences that determine nursing and patient care.

This lab consist of more modernized equipments like Cardiac Resuscitation manikin & actual dummies to demonstrate complex invasive procedures to impart affective domain of the curriculum under the supervision of qualified teachers.

MATERNITY & CHILD HEALTH LAB:

"The world needs midwives now more than ever"

As in par with the above saying midwives are key in health care. Skilled Maternity care & New Born care starts from this lab. The achievement of reduced maternal and Neonatal deaths requires a global commitment to grow a strong & well educated midwifery workforce. The functioning of health service delivery system is provided in this lab. An understanding of female reproductive health process enables the students to provide comprehensive care to woman who are prone to high risk during pregnancy.







COMMUNITY HEALTH LAB:

Nurses figure prominently in Primary Health Care delivery & development. They need broader determinants of health including education & practice to identify the risk factors, provide health education and information promotes the benefits of healthy life styles, diets & avoid high risk behaviours. This department prepares students to undertake socially conscious task of providing health care to both rural and urban communities. Our experienced staff provides excellent theoretical and practical orientation to students to prevent disease and promote positive health. Our students also participate in all the Govt. programmes.

MEDICAL SURGICAL NURSING LAB:

Nurses need to understand proper procedures in dealing with patient who have medical and surgical ailments. This lab orients students to various disease conditions in terms of etiology, clinical manifestations and various diagnostic procedures. The knowledge gained enables them to diagnose nursing problems, to plan nursing care and ensure complete recovering. Students are also taught to develop skills and handling life threatening situation.

DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRIC AND MENTAL HEALTH NURSING:

The complex living conditions and increasing stress and strain of life style had caused an increasing number of mental illness. Our students are sent to psychiatric institutions to get orientation to different types of mental illness and abnormal behavior patterns. Highly qualified teaching staff provides students with theoretical and practical insight to nurture the mental health.

NUTRITION LAB:

Nutrition is yet another special attention area in nursing. Here students are taught the fundamentals of preparing various type of diets. They learn to differentiate between wide variety of diet and diet patterns recommended for ailments like diabetes, diet for renal conditions, diet for hypertension, anaemia, ulcer, diabetes etc Nursing Students should know the vital role played by the nutrients to protect, promote & maintain the health.







ANATOMY LAB:

This lab is equipped with miniature live models, wet specimens, loose bones, skeletons, ample number of charts for easy way of learning complicated structures of human body.

COMPUTER LAB:

Computer has become a prime necessity in today's life. Keeping in par with the same trend we have a well equipped computer lab with High speed internet facilities. The lab is organized with computers with a maximum of 20 students at a time to learn & search the inner core.



ONAM:


